One binder is needed with (2) Section Dividers for Science Vocabulary and Writing Assignments. Each section must have sheets of lined notebook paper.

A Second binder is needed for America the Beautiful with at least 90 sheets of lined notebook paper and (3) Sturdy Folders. Section Dividers for History Vocabulary Words is suggested.

Parents will need to cover Math, Grammar, and Physical Education at home. No further instruction in the areas of Bible, Science, History, Writing, Music/Art, or Elective is needed. Our Grace and Glory Guidebook, provides weekly lesson plans, demonstrating campus and home assignments.

There will be occasions in which we'll ask that students bring an item from home, to use in Science Labs or History Projects; utilizing kitchen tools and household items, can help us keep our program costs down.

Parents with littles ages 0-3yrs, can participate in Little Tugboats co-op. A co-op is a group of mothers who meet to cooperatively work together, to achieve a common goal.
