Tuition installments shall be due by the 7th of each month: August – May 2017/18

Registration	\$75 per family	Due in full at the time of enrollment.
Supply Fee	\$25 per student	Due in full at the time of enrollment.
Choose to participate as Members (\$350 Per Family) or NonMembers (\$100 Per Student)		
Tuition Per Student	K4 & K5	\$375 per semester, per student or 10 digital installments @\$75ea
	First, Second, Third	\$400 per semester, per student or 10 digital installments @\$80ea
	Fourth, Fifth	\$425 per semester, per student or 10 digital installments @\$85ea
	Middle School	\$475 per semester, per student or 10 digital installments @\$95
Volunteer Discount	Parents of students in grades K-3rd	receive a \$50 discount per student, with a signed volunteer contract. (assist a few times per year, in your child's class)
	Parents of students in grades 4th-8th	receive a \$100 discount per student, with a signed volunteer contract. (assist a few times per year, in Science labs)
Drop Off Payments	Add \$5 per installment, per student, for choosing a Manual Drop-Off Payment Plan of Cash or Check, instead of digital payments.	
All fees are non-refundable once submitted, including in the event of withdrawal or expulsion.		

We do not accept government funds; families must cover their own payments.

Grace and Glory payments may not be used as a California tax write off.

Priority enrollment for classes, will be given to **Members**. An **Enrollment Packet** must be completed by all families who are enrolling in Grace and Glory; continuing families must enroll each new academic year.
