Middle School students will also meet an additional 1-2 times per month (outside of Wednesdays) for fun outings, service projects and separate age-appropriate field trips.



Charlotte Mason Inspired:

Our Wednesday program is **Charlotte Mason inspired** with Hymn Study, Scripture Memory, Habit Training, Fine Arts, Nature Study and Kindergarten Living Math.

Utilizing the Abeka Christian Worldview Readers for History and Science grades 1, 2, 3, we encourage Read Aloud time with Living Books and Copywork to be followed up at home, by the parent.

By 4th grade we transition to Abeka's project based report books for History/Geography and introduce laboratory science with Christian Kids Explore Chemistry. A list of Living Books for science, is provided for independent reading at home.

For Middle School, we foster student independence, responsibility, and new challenges by utilizing Notgrass America the Beautiful – a single author living book style History curriculum incorporating the “science of relations” with coordinating Bible, Creative Writing, and Literature included in the curriculum. There are two levels of literature books to choose from. Middle School students also engage in laboratory science with Christian Kids Explore Chemistry. We branch out by incorporating a casual introduction to Logic with The Logic Fallacies Detective and round our classes out with an introduction to formal writing mechanics with Apologia Jump In Writing.

Uniform Attire:

Elementary students must wear a Uniform polo shirt in the colors of Navy, White, Yellow or Forest Green. Middle School students must wear solid color shirts (any style, no tank tops). Please reference our Dress Code section in the Family Handbook, for more details.

Required Books:

Grades K-3rd student books must be submitted to your child's teacher at Back to School Night. Books will remain with the teacher for the duration of the school term. Grades 4+ will keep their books with them throughout the school year. Parents are still required to bring their students books for check-in, at Back to School Night.
