### High School Requirements -

[Before July 31st of your student's 9th grade year:](#) if your family plans to homeschool through high school, both parent(s) and student agree to meet with GGHS Administration to create a **Four Year Plan** and **choose a High School Path** of General Ed or Honors College Prep.

We strongly advise against transferring between homeschool/public school/private school during the high school years.

[Before the first day of your student's 9th grade attendance:](#) the teaching parent(s) must submit the following forms completed in their entirety, in addition to fulfilling financial obligations:

- Grace and Glory High School Course Descriptions (1 per subject, annually)
- Grace and Glory Curriculum Report and Academic Plan (1 annually)
- High School Path Selection (typed, in your own words)

[Before the first day of your student's 12th grade attendance:](#) the teaching parent(s) must provide a portfolio sampling of the students work, to keep with their high school transcript.

[Before the last day of your student's 12th grade attendance:](#) the student must pass the CHSPE or BASE TEST, as well as complete all 9-12th course requirements in alignment with the state of California guidelines, and submit a written essay report in MLA format.

**Please note:** early graduation will not be granted unless a student is of 17 years of age or can provide proof of enrollment in a college or trade school.
