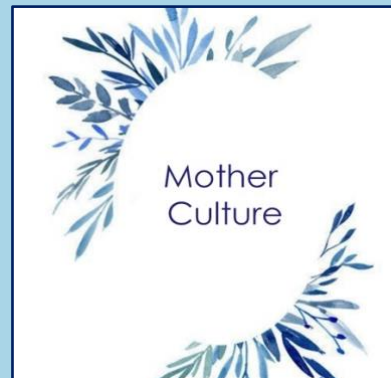

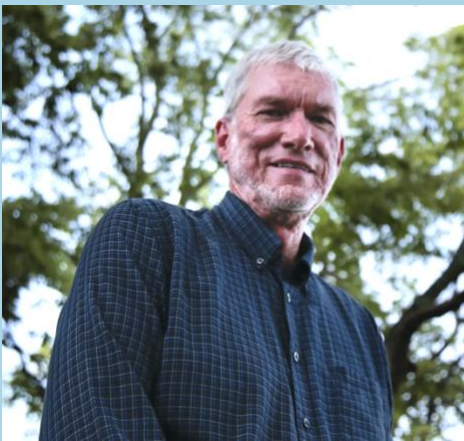
TEENS Life Group Tutor: Riley Nevarez

Student Supplies: IEW Student Book

Description: Strengthen your student's composition skills and understanding of scripture, using exciting stories straight from the Bible! All lessons begin with a scriptural source text, followed by a variety of assignments such as outlines, essays, etc. Checklists and a grading rubric are included. 8 homework assignments are mandatory for the fall session; a three strikes rule will apply. The revised 2019 version of the Bible Based Writing book was released this Spring; each student will need a current version of the consumable student book.



TEENS Life Group DVD Speaker: Ken Ham

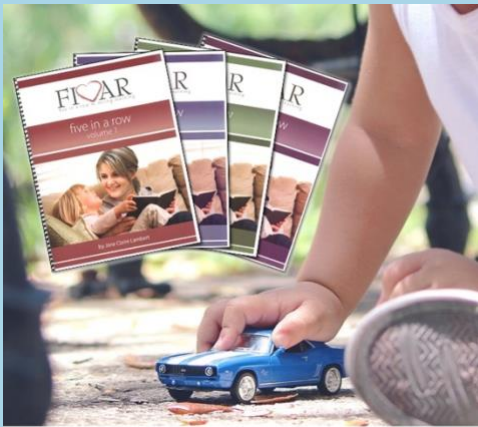
For Apologetics DVD Class – Monday Mornings

Develop your children's appetite for good literature at a young age! "Five in a row" guides contain literature-based unit studies, utilizing quality, classic books! The reason it's called "Five in a Row" is because you can use each book to read 1, 2, 3, 4 or 5 times in a row each week. I had the pleasure of using Five in a Row when my big kids were little....and I am excited to do it again with my youngest.

>Age Groupings:

Ages 2-4yrs BEFORE Five In A Row: Facilitator needed

Ages 4-8yrs Five In a Row Volume 1: Facilitator Michaela Roekle

FIAR can be used as your core curriculum, (adding math & phonics) or as a supplement.

Ages 8-12yrs BEYOND Five in a Row: Facilitator needed

FIAR can be used as your core curriculum, (adding math & grammar) or as a supplement. Chapter books replace picture books at this level and each book lasts 6-8wks.

>Structure:

Whether you have a visual, auditory, hands-on learner or special needs to consider, FIAR has activities your student can enjoy! There are MORE activity suggestions than we could possibly cover and plenty of ideas for discussions, crafts, projects and valuable life lessons.

Each mom will rotate taking turns, prepping supplies to bring for the book of the week!

Before Book Club Meetings:

- 1: Read the book together at home.
 - 2: Pack your child's folder, clipboard and pencil box in his/her backpack.
- >The "Prep Mom", will prep and pack her box of materials for the group activities.

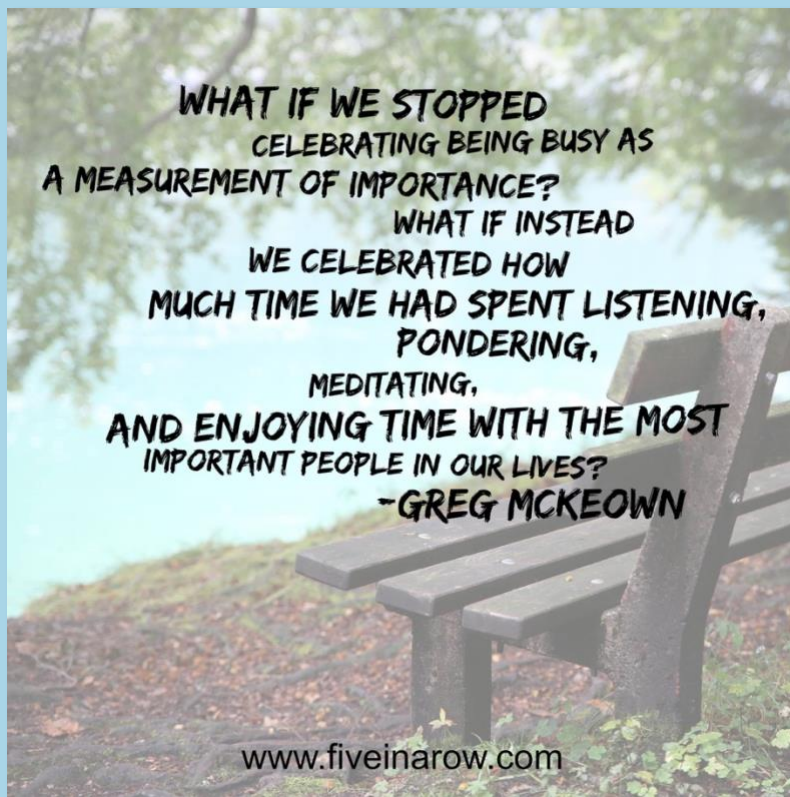
At Book Club Monday Meetings:
