

FIELD TRIP GUIDELINES

We have set up the following guidelines for Grace and Glory field trips, with the hope that our group will be a good witness for Christ wherever we go, as well as shine a positive light on homeschooling for today.

- 1. Please contact the field trip organizer as early as possible, if for any reason you are not able to attend an event that you signed up for. This can help open up spots on our waiting list for others to take your place AND this ensures our guide/docent can adjust plans if needed ©
- **2. Arrive on time!** Out of respect for others, please don't be late. Allow extra time for traffic, getting lost, parking and walking. One late family can hold up an entire group \otimes
- **3. Kindly stay with your children.** You are personally responsible for your children's behavior and safety. It's a good idea to remind your children of any expectations during a particular outing. Even before you sign up, consider how young children may engage appropriately on certain field trips which might be geared towards older children ©
- **4. Encourage your children to listen** when school leaders and docents are speaking. Strive to model active listening and joyful participation on field trips with your children. It can actually be quite distracting when moms socialize on the side, instead of participate \otimes
- **5. Attire and shoes** should be modest and appropriate for the outing. Remember to check field trip details in your email before arriving ⁽³⁾
- **6. If little ones or students of any age should become disruptive**, please excuse yourself to handle the situation away from the group \odot
- **7. Practice common courtesy...** children or teens of any age should not be allowed to climb, touch, or handle things before asking permission from the venue ©
- 8. Do not bring extra guests without checking with a school leader in advance ©
- 9. Thank your guide when possible! Gratitude is appreciated for volunteers @
- 10. Field Trip payments are NON-REFUNDABLE but may be transferrable when possible.
