### GGHS Jr/Sr High Requirements -

[Before July 31st of your 9th grade year:](#) if your family plans to homeschool through high school, both parent(s) and student agree to meet with GGHS Administration to create a **Four Year Plan** and **choose a High School Path** of General Ed, Honors or High Honors.

We strongly advise against transferring between homeschool/publicschool/privateschool during the high school years; families should receive a confirmation of God's calling, before making a commitment.

[Before the first day of your 9th grade attendance:](#) the teaching parent(s) must submit the following forms completed in their entirety, in addition to fulfilling financial obligations:

- GGHS High School Course Descriptions
  - GGHS Course Of Study (overview for all courses; same for grades k-12)
  - GGHS High School Path Selection (typed, in your own words)
  - Begin the GGHS High School Transcript
- \*\*all forms must be submitted each year for grades 9-12th

[Before the first day of your 12th grade attendance:](#) the teaching parent(s) must provide a sampling of the students work to keep with their highschool transcript.

[Before the last day of your 12th grade attendance:](#) the student must pass the CHSPE Test or a similarly equivalent test, complete all 9-12 course requirements in alignment with the state of California guidelines, as well as:

- complete a written essay
- complete an oral essay
- work with the teaching parent(s) to complete all necessary records and paperwork including the official high school transcript.

Please note: early graduation will not be granted unless a student is of 18 years of age or can provide proof of enrollment in a college or trade school.
